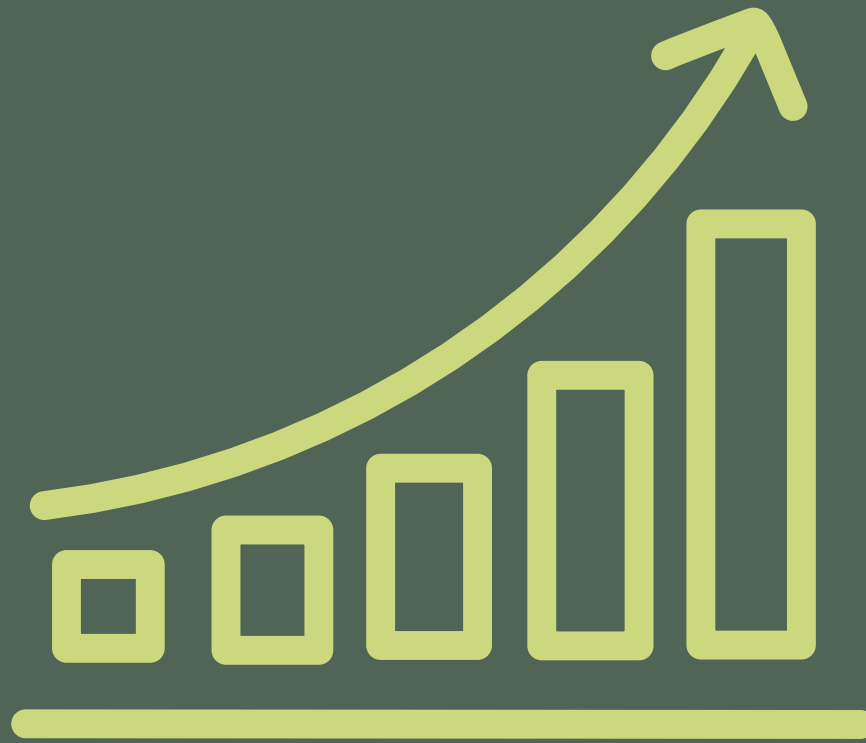


Support from other parents mattered
