

Start on Success: A COLLABORATION MODEL OFFERING WORK-BASED LEARNING FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Virginia's Start on Success(SOS) program is designed for high school seniors with disabilities who are pursuing a standard or advanced studies diploma. SWD should be provided opportunities to increase career pathway skills through Work Based Learning. To increase student success, SOS components consist of four evidence-based practices related to in-school or post-school success for students with disabilities (Test, et al., 2009). These SOS core components contribute to the success of the program.

- (2) Career and technical education (CTE) course
- (3) Paid Internship
- (4) Mentorship



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
